A symbol of college attainment, the "PLUS Center" is structured within the walls of each partner school and functions as a central hub for all college readiness and access services for the entire student body.

Since its inception, 12+ has helped open doors for over 2000 students, measurably improving their graduation and post-secondary outcomes. This success has not only helped to foster meaningful, sustainable change for students and high schools alike; it has also brought 12+ national recognition as a model educational program that helps students succeed in college as well as in life.
