Your gift will provide one children's book in Spanish.

"Read it. Love it. Pass it on."

These words are on each book in a decorated box at a local laundromat. They sum up the mission of the Laundromat Library League, which creates mini-libraries in laundromats. Children of all ages, many from families unable to afford books, are invited while awaiting their laundry, to read a book, take it home, and pass it to another child.

Founded in 2014 by two Chester County, PA, women, the League has 225 sites in 30 states. It has received more than 100,000 books, most from libraries, schools, homes, and book sale leftovers. Donations have paid for hundreds more in Spanish or with multicultural themes. Volunteers recruit laundromat owners to participate, create colorful boxes for the books, and replenish books as needed.
