



## Swarthmore Presbyterian Nursery Day School 2025-2026 Programs

We're delighted that you're interested in having your child attend SPNDS for the 2025-2026 school year! SPNDS is <u>the place</u> for "Learning Joy," and we'd love for your child (ren) to be a part of our school family. Our Programs At-A-Glance

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Play Pals 9:15-11:15 a.m. 5 days/week	The perfect introduction to preschool! In our program for 2-year-olds, our youngest learners will engage in play activities that are "just right" for this age group. This is a drop-off program, though parents may stay for the first orientation class. NOTE: Students do NOT need to be potty-trained to enroll in Play Pals but must be 2 years-old by September 1st of the year of enrollment.						
Nursery Day School 9:00-11:45 a.m., M-F, 5 days/week	All areas of development—social, emotional, cognitive, and physical—are of equal importance at Nursery Day School. Our curriculum emerges as children participate in hands-on, play-based activities. Readiness skills are adeptly integrated into these activities. We help children express their individuality while learning to respect the rights of others. Outdoor play is an important part of our program, and all students participate in our Specials classes: Music, Art, Creative Movement, Science, Library and Woodshop. Students bring water bottles and snacks from home. NOTE: Nursery Day School students must be potty-trained and turn 3 years-old by September 1 of the year of enrollment.						
Kindergarten Complement AM: 9:00 a.m12:15 p.m. PM: 11:45 a.m2:45 p.m. M-F, 5 days/week	In our Complement program, we reinforce and apply concepts and skills learned in kindergarten, while also enriching this education through the exploration of ideas and themes. We also offer students the time, space, and structure to play and socialize. Like in Nursery Day School, all students participate in outdoor play as well as our Specials classes: Music, Art, Creative Movement, Music, and Woodshop. We offer one kindergarten complement class in the morning and two classes in the afternoon. Space is limited, and we strongly encourage you NOT to wait for the Wallingford-Swarthmore School District (WSSD) kindergarten lottery in March to apply. We will work with families as much as possible post-lottery if a change is required. Note: Only children in the WSSD can ride the buses to or from their elementary school and SPNDS.						
Lunch Bunch for Nursery Day School Students 11:45 a.m2:45 p.m. Minimum of 2 days/ week	Students eat lunch together and participate in a variety of academic and social activities after Nursery Day School ends. We require families to enroll for a minimum of two days per week. We suggest that you sign up for the days you expect to need and inform the office ASAP if your plans change. (We found it's much easier to reduce the number of days than to increase later in the year.)  NOTE: Students bring their own lunch and drink from home. Rest and nap times are permitted.						
<b>Early Bird</b> , 8:15-9 a.m. <b>Stay &amp; Play</b> , 2:45-3:30 p.m.	Early Bird (for Nursery Day School students and AM Kindergarten Complement) and Stay & Play (for Lunch Bunch students and PM Kindergarten Complement) are available to better accommodate parents' daily schedules. There is an additional fee for these programs, and enrollment is limited. We require a minimum of two days per week.						

## Admissions Next Steps

- Applications from **CURRENT** students and alumni families that include the \$75 registration fee will be accepted beginning **Tuesday**, **January 21**, **through Friday**, **January 31**, **2025**.
- Applications from NEW students that include the \$75 registration fee will be accepted beginning Monday, February 3, 2025, at 8 am. Applications handed directly to the Director or Administrative Assistant will take precedence over applications mailed, emailed or put in the drop box.

Please note that our classes fill quickly, and children are generally enrolled on a "first come, first served" basis. We will continue to accept applications throughout the spring and summer if there are spaces available in our classes. Once we have reached full enrollment, a waitlist will be started. Our waitlist is only for the upcoming school year. All students must submit an application every year.

Acceptance letters are emailed with a contract in March and should be signed and returned to the school office by the date stated in your welcome email. The remaining enrollment paperwork will be available by email and on our website in the spring. All enrollment paperwork, including a health form and vaccination record, must be submitted by June 15th. Kindergarten enrollment contracts may be delayed depending on when the district elementary schools assign morning or afternoon placement to the enrolling kindergarteners.

## 2025-2026 Tuition Schedule and Application Fee

Each student's financial commitment is for the entire school year, and tuition is non-refundable except upon approval by the SPNDS Advisory Committee. Families may choose to pay the full-year tuition at once or in 10 installments.
